

## **COMPETITION FORMAT**

There will be 16 teams selected to compete, 8 Bhangra and 8 Garba-Raas. Bhangra and Garba-Raas teams WILL NOT be competing against each other. Each dance style will be judged separately.

MIXER DAY	<ul> <li>Teams are required to arrive by 4 PM on Friday, February 23rd to attend prop setup and the mandatory team mixer.</li> <li>Teams must stay at the designated East Coast Showdown hotel.</li> <li>Team Captains are required to attend a captain's meeting after the mixer.</li> </ul>
COMPETITION DAY	<ul> <li>A mandatory tech rehearsal at the show venue will take place on Saturday. Each team will be assigned 18 minutes of stage time. Following that, teams will have 10 minutes to watch their onstage rehearsal video and an additional 15 minutes of offstage rehearsal.</li> <li>The total length of performance must be a minimum of 5.5 minutes and a maximum of 7.5 minutes.</li> <li>Each team will be given 1.5 minutes to set up and take down props.</li> <li>The Intro Video may not exceed 1.5 minutes.</li> </ul>

## **COMPETITION FORMAT**

### **TEAM FORMAT**

- A minimum of **12 members** must be on the roster, not including alternate dancers. A maximum of 25 members, including any team managers, alternates, or any other non-performing member, may be on the roster. No additional roster member spots are offered.
- Each competing team must include current college/university students with a **MAXIMUM** of **2 non-current students** if affiliated with a particular university or college.
- If the team is an independent organization, then everyone on the roster except for two people must be currently enrolled at a university.
- All roster members must submit a **government-issued ID** as well as a **student ID** (unless they are one of the two non-university members on the team).
- Student and government IDs must be uploaded in the following format (.jpg or .png)

i. TeamName\_FirstNameLastName\_StudentID

ii. TeamName\_FirstNameLastName\_GovernmentID





# HOW TO APPLY

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINES AND FEES**



#### 1. Fill out the RAS Common Application on Ekta

#### a. Form link: https://ekta.app/

- Preliminary Roster Form: Please note that this is a preliminary roster and teams will have the option of editing the roster if accepted to perform at ECS 2024. Team photos must be at least 1920 by 1080 pixels and team logos must be at least 300 by 300 pixels. All images must be in .jpeg or .png format with the following name format.

#### 2. Submit the NON-refundable application fee.

- Include, in this order: Team Name, "Raas," and Regular or Late Application
- Please submit the correct amount based on the date you are submitting all your application materials by.
- The date we receive the payment will be used to determine whether your application will be considered regular or late.

If you cannot zelle or venmo please contact us via email or text so we can work out a different payment method.

#### 3. Submit an **audition video.**

All registration items must be submitted via the Ekta Application Portal by **11:59 PM EST** on the above dates. Once ALL of these materials have been received, you will receive a confirmation email from the registration chairs within 24 hours of submission.

# **AUDITION VIDEO**

## **Video Requirements:**

- 1. The video MUST be continuous dancing for 2:00- 2:30 minutes, with a 30-60 second Garba segment requirement.
- 2. The routine performed MUST reflect the current routine that is intended to be performed at each competition. Previous routines or performances will not be considered.
- 3.100% of the audition video dancers must be present in the video at all times, and their full bodies MUST be visible.
- 4. At least 80% of the roster members who were listed on the submitted dancing roster MUST be performing in the video.
- 5. Male and female dancers MUST wear different colored shirts to allow for visualization (no more than two standardized colors).
- 6. Camera MUST be fixed. There can only be one camera angle (front and center), and it cannot be zoomed or panned.
- 7. All formations MUST be visible.

## Video Restrictions:

- 1. No costumes or props are allowed in the video, except dandiyas.
- 2. No stunts, themes, dialogue, or voiceovers are permitted.
- 3. No intro/outro videos are allowed.
- 4. The video cannot be edited (MUST be continuous).
- 5. The video cannot have any special lighting or visual effects.
- 6. The audio and video must be good.
- 7. College/university or team-affiliated items MUST not be worn or seen in the video. This includes, but is not limited to: logo, mascot, symbol, slogan, colors, etc.

## Video Submission Rules:

1.Teams may overlay the audio.

2.The audio and video MUST be of high quality (720p or above)

in MP4 or .MOV format.

3.Each team MUST provide a Google Drive link to view and download an audition video.

4. The file name MUST be in the following format:

# TEAM ACCEPTANCES

#### **Accepted Teams**

Accepted teams will be notified by **Sunday, November 19th, 2023**. Once accepted, your team will have 72 hours from the time notified to accept or deny your spot in the East Coast Showdown lineup.

To confirm your acceptance:

-You must pay a security deposit of **\$200** within 72 hours of receiving the acceptance email.

-All fees can be paid via Venmo to @eastcoastshowdown or Zelle to eastcoastshowdown.uva@gmail.com

-Please make the payment private and include the Team Name and "Raas Acceptance Fee- Security Deposit".

#### **Waitlisted Teams**

All teams will automatically be placed on the waitlist and notified after the initial round of acceptances. Once notified, your team will have 48 hours to accept or deny your spot on the waitlist for ECS. If an opening occurs, waitlisted teams will be immediately notified and offered a spot on the lineup. Once notified, your team will have 48 hours from the time the email was sent to accept or deny your spot in the lineup. **To accept** your position, you MUST pay a security deposit of \$200 within 48 hours of receiving the acceptance email (venmo or zelle only).

#### **Security Deposit**

The security deposit will be returned to you after the competition weekend is over. Money from the security deposit may be deducted if there is any damage to the hotel rooms, mixer venue, after-party venue, or performance venue. Late fees incurred due to submission of post-registration materials after deadlines and notification of passed deadlines will also result in a deduction from the security deposit.

#### Per dancer fees post-acceptance

Teams will have to pay an individual fee of \$60 per roster member, for up to 25 members. No additional roster spots are offered. The per dancer fees will need to be paid by the deadline outlined in the postregistration packets.

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. The East Coast Showdown executive board may practice discretion with their selection process. Teams understand that the committee is not required to divulge any information regarding team selection, unless they see fit.
- 2. Garba-Raas teams do not need to be affiliated with a particular college/university.
- 3. Should a registered team choose to withdraw from the competition after accepting their invitation to East Coast Showdown, they will forfeit their security deposit and paid registration fees. This means that all fees that have been paid are NON-refundable. In addition, withdrawing AFTER the official lineup is released will result in a \$300 penalty.
- 4. Violence or rude behavior toward either the judges, other participants, staff at the venues and hotel, or members of the ECS board will result in point deductions or immediate disqualification, all **determined at the discretion of the ECS board**.
- 5. Payment of the security deposit acknowledges agreement to the outlined rules and regulations.
- 6. Any rules, outlined presently and in the future, that are violated will lead to an individual's or a team's disqualification, depending on the severity of the violation. The final decision will be determined by the East Coast Showdown Executive board.
- 7. The East Coast Showdown event coordinators reserve the right to add new rules and subtract or revise existing rules as seen fit. All teams will be notified of any changes made.
